Leamington Cricket club has the following Code of Conduct for officials, coaches and volunteers:

All Leamington Cricket Club Officials, Coaches and Volunteers will:

- Consider the well-being and safety of participants before the development of performance.
- Develop an appropriate working relationship with players, based on mutual trust and respect.
- Make sure all activities are appropriate to the age, ability and experience of those taking part.
- Promote the positive aspects of the sport (e.g. fair play).
- Display consistently high standards of behaviour and appearance.
- Follow all guidelines laid down by the national governing body and the Club.
- Must make themselves familiar with and adhere to Leamington Cricket club's policy's on bullying and the use of social media.
- Have appropriate insurance cover.
- Never exert undue influence over players to obtain personal benefit or reward.
- Never condone rule violations, unfair play or the use of prohibited substances.
- It is desirable that Leamington Cricket Officials and Volunteers have read:
 - ECB 'Safe Hands – Welfare of Young People in Cricket' policy.
 - Leamington Cricket Club's safeguarding, use of social media and bullying policies

- Hold the appropriate, valid qualifications for Cricket Coaching
